## ENTRIES

## Entrants in Events shall be:

a) Eligible persons as defined in Skate Canada Rule Book Section 2100
b) Be Associate members in good standing of the Association. All event entries will be accepted only from skaters who are members of affiliated Skate Canada clubs.

## CLOSING DATE OF ENTRIES

All entries must be registered online no later than May 16, 2024 by 12pm MST. It is the responsibility of the skater to ensure that their entry is in to the Host Committee Registration person by the closing date. Crowfoot skaters will receive priority registration between April 20-30, 2024. Registration will open to all Calgary clubs on April 12, 2024 at 9:00 AM.

## LATE ENTRIES

There will be absolutely no late entries accepted after the deadline. No exceptions.

## WITHDRAWAL/REFUND OF ENTRY FEES

Entry fees shall be refunded only if the event is not held. Any changes or withdrawals may be requested before the closing date and will occur a fee of $\$ 10$. No refunds will be made after the closing date (May 16) for any reason, including medical pulls. No exceptions.

## AWARDS
